- I. The main thesis – God has not rejected his people (vv. 1-6)
  - A. The question – has God rejected his people? (v. 1a)
  - B. The answer (vv. 1b-4)
    - 1. The answer stated (v. 1b-1c)
      - a. Absolutely not! (v. 1b)
      - b. The personal evidence (v. 1c)
    - 2. The answer restated (vv. 2-4)
      - God has not cast away his people (v. 2a)
        - a. The theological evidence (v. 2a)
        - b. The biblical evidence [1 Kings 19:1-18] (vv. 2b-4)
          - 1) Elijah's complaint (v. 3)
          - 2) God's response (v. 4)
  - C. The conclusion – God is faithful (vv. 5-6)
    - 1. God has preserved a remnant (v. 5)
    - 2. God's preservation is an act of grace (v. 6)
- II. The main thesis explained in the current context (vv. 7-10)
  - A. Israel's current situation summarized (v. 7)
    - 1. The nation of Israel as a whole
    - 2. The elect within Israel
    - 3. The "blinded" within Israel
  - B. Israel's "blindness" explained from the OT (vv. 8-10)
    - 1. From the law and the prophets [Deut. 29:4, Is. 29:10] (v. 8)
    - 2. From the writings [Psalm 69:22-23] (vv. 9-10)
